## Importer Security Filing ("ISF")

- Required by § 203 of SAFE Port Act of 2006
- Also known as "10 + 2"
- Consists of 10 pieces of information filed by the importer and 2 from the carrier
- Applies to ocean freight only (for now)
- Must be filed at least 24 hours prior to loading at foreign port
- Interim Final Rule effective 1/26/2009
- Compliance date 1/26/2010
  - Liquidated Damages \$5000 per violation

#### Implementation Mechanics

- Importer of record is responsible for filing
- Filing must be done by a single party
  - Information may be obtained from multiple parties

# Data Elements provided by the Importer of Record:

- 2. Buyer name & address
- 3. Importer of record number
- 4. Consignee number
- 5. Manufacturer (or supplier) name & address
- 6. Ship to name & address
- 7. Country of origin of the goods
- 8. Harmonized Tariff Schedule (6 digit)
- 9. Container stuffing location
- 10. Consolidator name & address

- House Bill of Lading Number including SCAC Code
- EstimatedLoading Date
- Estimated SailingDate
- Estimated ArrivalDate
- Origin Port
- Destination Port
- PO Number
